- 8. Authors use different techniques to make you want to turn the page to see what happens next. Can you find examples of these?
 - Ellipsis (...)
 - Using words like then, if, when, because, except
 - Asking a question
 - Pictures or words that make us wonder what happens next
- 9. Do you have a favorite illustration? How do the pictures help to tell the story?
- 10. How does the Bible verse at the beginning of the book fit in with Little Roo's story?
